

The Mixed Choir
VOKÁL Přerov

The mixed choir VOKÁL was founded in 1963 by the Engineering Works Přerov. After the decline of its founder the choir became independent and since 1990 it has worked as a civic association. It is a member of the Union of Czech Vocal Choirs.

The repertoire of VOKÁL consists of music of all periods from the renaissance to contemporary music, folk-songs, spirituals, etc. The choir regularly performs concerts at home as well as abroad, takes part in international competitions in Olomouc (CR), Szolnok (H), Marcelino (I) where it has been awarded numerous prizes, mostly silver and gold medals. VOKÁL has performed in England, Belgium, Hungary, Germany, Poland, Austria and the Netherlands. It also made recordings for the Czech Radio and the Czech Television and in 1998 it published its first CD.

There have been different conductors working with the choir. Since 1999, the choir has been directed by Kamila Fojtová who graduated from the Janáček's Academy of Art in Brno under the supervision of the associate professor Lubomír Mátl.
